1. SAMS After-School Program (2016-17 & 2017-18)

- Kelley Greenleaf, Skowhegan Area Middle School program coordinator, provided an overview of the 2016-17 after-school program as well as an update on programming for the current school year.

2. Improving Outcomes for Youth Grant: 9-12 After-School Program

- Heather Johnson, Executive Director of the Somerset Economic Development Corporation, shared details on a grant which can provide after-school programming to students in area high schools. The after-school program would likely run two days per week and would be focused on workforce development skills, providing students' academic supports, and other supports for students.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board support the grant through the establishment of a no cost after-school program at Skowhegan Area High School in collaboration with the Somerset Economic Development Corporation.

3. Policy Review: JLC

- MSAD54 nurses Debbie Lancaster and Stephanie Voter reviewed revisions to policy JLC: STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AND REQUIREMENTS (FILE: JLC, JLCB, JLCC, JLCD); Adjustments were made primarily to sections E Administration of Medication to Students and F Administration of Medication by School Personnel. Adjustments

were made to reflect current practice and to incorporate updated recommended policy language.
