1. Committee Reorganization

The Committee reorganized. Amy Rouse was elected Chair and Maryellen Charles was elected Vice-Chair. The quorum was set at 5.

2. <u>Update on the Skowhegan Area High School BARR Program</u>

Mr. Mochamer introduced Assistant Principal Jason Bellerose and Guidance Counselor Dan Riley, who presented on the success of the Freshman Building Assets Reducing Risks: BARR program at Skowhegan Area High School. Highlights of BARR outcomes include:

- Strong teacher-student relationships
- Excellent communication with families
- Team meetings and coordination between teachers
- Support and interventions for students who struggle

BARR data was highlighted including most notably a dramatic drop (over 75%) in failure rate for students in their Freshmen year (from 42% in 15-16 to 9.2% this past year).

The Committee thanked Mr. Mochamer and his staff for the presentation and asked him to commend his staff for their efforts. There will be future updates.

3. Policy Review

The Committee reviewed and revised MSMA Sample Policy IMG, Animals in Schools.
