1. Contracted Services

Process, procurement:

Discussion of the need to have reliable, dependable licensed contractors available 24 hours per day seven days a week and the importance of having contractors who have extensive knowledge of the district. We will look into an RFQ process for long term stability of district needs.

2. <u>Building Project Update</u>

Modular classrooms disposal discussion:

We are preparing for the closing of Margaret Chase Smith in June of 2025. Part of this process includes the removal of the portable classrooms. This will need to take place in the time frame of one week after school closes. Hence the desire to put them out to bid this summer so potential buyers can plan for the relocation on their end.
