1. <u>Update on generator proposal:</u>

An estimate of \$13,000 to install a 20kW generator that will service and protect the server farm located at SAMS has been received. This will cover the district wide servers and maintain the temperature in the space.

RECOMMENDATION: That the School Board approve the installation of a 20kW generator at a cost not to exceed \$13,000.

2. <u>Permission to Accept Funds:</u>
